### **Universal Health Coverage Round Table Discussion**

**The session will take place on Day 2 of the Research Symposium, 16<sup>th</sup> March, between 1.30 pm and 3.30 pm at the Indian School of Business, Hyderabad.**

The roundtable discussion will be essentially be around the recommendations of the HLEG Report on 'Universal Health Coverage' and will have about 5 researchers from the PHFI technical team and 3 senior faculty from PHFI as discussants.

The key idea behind this session is to not only give an overview of the framework of recommendations and the evidence that supports them, but equally indicate lacunae in available research data and outline potential areas of future research under the various terms of reference.

The session will last 2 hours, with each participant having 12 minutes for their presentation. This will be followed by the Discussants sharing their opinions and views on UHC for 15 minutes each. We will then open the session to the audience for a Questions & Answers discussion.
